MASONRY BRUSH

Our specially designed durable Masonry brush is made using a blend of pure and synthetic bristles, making it ideal for exterior surfaces.

Available Sizes:

Product Overview:

The Farrow & Ball Masonry Brush is made from a combination of synthetic and pure bristle to give the best performance when painting more challenging exterior surfaces such as the more abrasive masonry surfaces. The Masonry Brush features an easy grip FSC approved Birch handle and Stainless Steel ferrule and pins which will not rust.

Product Uses:

For use on smooth and coarse outdoor masonry surfaces. For use with Farrow & Ball Exterior Masonry only.

Preparation of Brush:

Before the first use, we recommend that the brush bristles are washed with clean, cold water and dried carefully using a soft, lint free cloth or paper towel.

Painting with Brush:

Painting exterior walls: Apply the paint in a vertical direction then spread the paint out evenly in a horizontal direction taking care not to apply too thickly in any hollows and angled sections. On application of the final coat lay off the paint in a single direction to ensure that any brush marks and brush patterning effects (sometimes visible in certain lighting conditions) are minimised.

Clean Up:

Clean brushes with warm soapy water. Do not use hot water as this may cause the paint to form agglomerates (small lumps) in the bristles. Do not use solvent based brush cleaners as this may damage the synthetic bristles.

Drying:

Shake excess water off the bristles using a sharp flicking action. Wrap the bristles tightly in a paper towel and allow to dry naturally.

Storage:

When thoroughly dry, the brush may be returned to the cardboard sleeve to protect it during storage. If you are intending to use the brush to apply a second coat of the same finish and colour after a minimum of 4 hours (but not longer than 24 hours), you can simply wrap the bristles tightly in a plastic bag or air-tight cling film between use to retain moisture to save cleaning.

Considerations:

We do not recommend the Farrow & Ball Masonry Brush for use with solvent based paints.

Do not paint in temperatures below 10°C or in excessive heat above 30°C.

Avoid painting in direct sunlight.

Avoid applying outdoors if there is a likelihood of rain. For best results apply early in the day, allowing the product time to dry before the evening (when condensation can occur).
