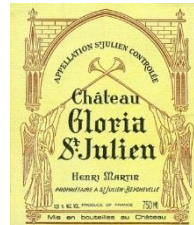


Château Gloria

De wijngaarden van Château Gloria liggen verspreid over het centrum van Beychevelle, het westen en het noorden van de appellatie grenzend aan Pauillac. Château Gloria werd opgericht door Henri Martin. Hij heeft met heel veel zorg de beste percelen uitgezocht, uitsluitend *grands crus* volgens de classificatie van 1855. De oorsprong van het terroir en de uitstekende zorg besteed aan de wijngaarden en de vinificatie verklaren de hoogstaande kwaliteit van deze schitterende wijn.

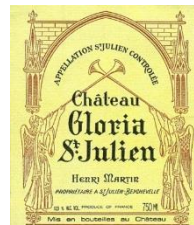
Graves gunzienne, op een ondergrond van klei en zand.

Handmatige oogst. Traditionele vinificatie in inox vaten onder gecontroleerde temperatuur.

30/11/2017 JEB DUNNUCK (JEB DUNNUCK) : 89 / 100



The 2014 Château Gloria is a solid, classically styled effort that shows the more reserved style of this vintage beautifully. Offering notes of red and black currants, leafy herbs and tobacco, cedar, and forest floor, it has solid purity of fruit, medium-bodied density, a silky texture and a charming, albeit straightforward style. Drink it anytime over the coming 10-15 years.

Super aromas of blackberries, minerals, roses and spices. Full body, firm tannins and a long and beautiful finish. Fantastic center palate. Like a tight ball of silky thread. Seamless. Try drinking in 2020.

A grippy style, with a pleasantly rugged edge to the copious brambly tannins that push the core of plum and blackberry reduction along. Lots of licorice snap and tobacco notes show on the finish, which offers persistent grip. Delivers more guts than polish, but will age solidly. Best from 2020 through 2030. 16,665 cases made.

The 2014 Gloria is a bold, powerful wine. Dark cherry, smoke, licorice, tobacco and underbrush effortlessly fill out its frame. Ample and richly textured, the 2014 offers remarkable depth, power and pure pedigree. Pomegranate, blood orange and iron add further complexity on the finish. This is a superb showing. Tasted two times.

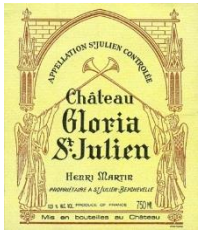


The 2014 Gloria is ample, rich and beautifully resonant, with more than enough fruit to fill out its broad-shouldered frame. Red currant, blood orange, smoke, white pepper and iron build to the deeply satisfying finish. The combination of extroverted fruit, tannin and saline-inflected minerality dazzles from the very first taste. What a gorgeous wine this is.

The Château Gloria 2014 has a focused, straight-laced bouquet with strict redcurrant and wild strawberry fruit, tightly wound at first but opening with aeration, tobacco and even flint emerging with time. The palate is medium-bodied with firm, dry tannin, a little chalkiness under those broody black fruit, the foundation of a classic, almost austere finish the nevertheless offers length and sustain. This actually harks back to the fine old Gloria's of the past, a little rustic perhaps, but a wine that I think will blossom in bottle. This will need to prove itself in bottle.

Balanced and elegant with upfront blackberry fruit with cedar. The tannins are firm and balanced with plenty of flavors to enjoy and savor over the next 6 to 8 years.

Exuberant, spicy black fruits – rich and ripe with a hint of leather. Has vigour and depth, will open up soon but last well. Drink: 2018-2028 (89)

60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Merlot, 4% Cabernet Franc, 6% Petit Verdot. 45% new oak. 36 hl/ha. All vinified in their new(ish) chai. Bright crimson. Refined salty-savoury nose. Aromatic and sweetly fresh. Racy and lightly grainy. Lots of freshness but no excess acidity. Light tannic charge on the end with a rich peacock's tail finish. Full of charm. Real drive to this wine. Drink 2020-2032 (16.5+)

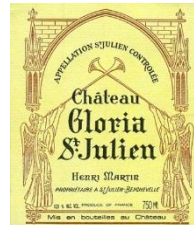

Unique en son genre puisque ce vignoble a été constitué pièce par pièces sur plusieurs années par l'achat de parcelles provenant exclusivement de grands crus classés en 1855. L'origine des terroirs, le soin apporté à la culture et à la vinification, expliquent sa qualité mondialement reconnue.
