

HOW TO CREATE SUPER SMOOTH GLOSS BLACK

Keeping or creating high gloss films smooth and glossy is possible. However, you have to treat them frequently.



Using the right squeegee buffer is the most important thing to do during application.



SOTT's WrapEdge™ squeegee buffers are the best buffers in the market to get the most smooth scratchless installation possible.



SOTT's special wax polish for gloss films will create a protective layer on top, and the glossiness and color depth will increase.

How to treat High Gloss films *(specially W-1400 Cursed Black)*

SOTT's wrap film Cursed Black W-1400 is a super smooth glossy black cast pvc film with flexible characteristics. Because of the softness and flexibility, its perfect for wrapping mirrors, hoods and roofs of vehicles.

SOME IMPORTANT NOTES TO GET THE PERFECT RESULT:

W-1400 Cursed Black has a synthetic protection layer to keep the facestock smooth and scratchless. You have to remove it before or after installation.

To prevent scratches during squeegeeing, we strongly recommend SOTT's WrapEdge™ buffers and make them wet. These buffers has a foam layer who will adsorb moisture and keep the buffer wet and helps to glide better during contact with the film.

W-1400 Cursed Black has a sort of white haze on the facestock. Don't worry. We recommend to polish the film with a high performance wax or nanotech polish system for gloss car paints. This will result in a perfect super smooth high gloss top layer and helps to avoid dirt and scratches during the upcoming months.

WE RECOMMEND:

- SOTT WrapEdge™ buffers Available in 0mm, 1mm, 2mm and 3mm sponge thickness
- SOTT Carwrap Polish Part no. 600-CP45

NOTE:

Keep in mind that ALL high gloss pvc films will scratch. The higher the gloss, the more scratches you will see. And because of the softness and flexibility, the possibility of scratches increases too. SOTT made the choice to develop an average gloss film and recommend to use a wax or polish to increase the gloss level.
