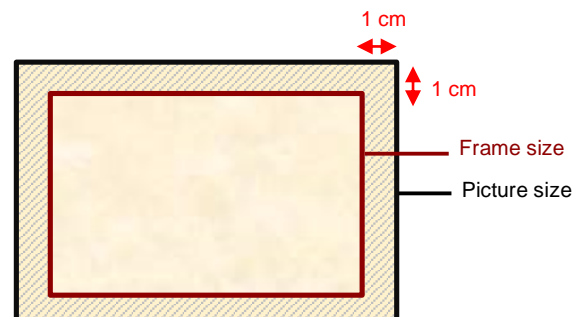
How do I need to prepare my print files?

FILE FORMAT

- PDF
- JPG

PICTURE SIZE

- Frame size
+ 1cm bleed all around



COLOUR SPACE

- **CMYK**
- Other colours will be printed in CMYK.
Thereby, colour variations can occur. Please contact us if you want to print a certain colour.
- Please be aware that the monitor display is not relevant for the valuation of the colour.

FILE SIZE

- Upload max. 25 MB
- Please contact us for larger files

FILE RESOLUTION

Viewing distance	Data resolution 1:1
0 – 2 m	min. 120 DPI recommended
2 – 5 m	min. 75 DPI recommended
> 5 m	min. 50 DPI (lower resolution is not printable)

How do I calculate the necessary resolution if I don't have the DPI of the image?

$\frac{\text{Desired size in cm}}{2,54} \times \text{Desired DPI}$
--

Example:

Image in 400 cm width, desired: min. 50 DPI

$$\frac{400 \text{ cm}}{2,54} \times 50 \text{ DPI}$$

$$= 157,48 \text{ inch} \times 50 \text{ DPI}$$

$$= 7874 \text{ pixel}$$

→ *The image should have at least 7874 pixel in width*
